

Items to Bring

- Warm Weather Hunting Clothing
- Cold Weather Hunting Clothing
- Rain gear (All gun hunts will be conducted out of heated blinds; archery hunts are designed for trees-stands. We can also utilize blinds with archery hunters if needed.)
 - Archery Hunters – Please Bring Your Safety Harnesses and Straps, they are required!
- Binoculars
- Range Finder
- Proper weapon and corresponding ammo for the hunting season
- Blaze orange hat and vest (for gun seasons)
*Please note that blaze orange must be solid orange and cannot be a blaze orange camo pattern.
- Waterproof boots (knee high for crossing creeks)
- Slippers for lodge wear
- Toiletries (we have scent free hunting soap and shampoo on hand, however hunters are encouraged to bring their own)
- Cases for your bow or gun
- Cooler to transport meat/horns home (if traveling with vehicle)
- Tags and hunting license
- Extra pairs of underwear and socks
- Extra pairs of gloves
- Grunt calls, rattling antlers, preferred hunting scents etc (we will go over what calls and scents to use or not use before your hunt, I also have Pure Whitetail scents on hand that can be purchased for use during the hunt)
- Money for the balance of the hunt if not paid ahead of time
- Gratuity money
- Cell phone charger (our main lodge does have wifi for laptops as well)
- Any other hunting gear needed
 - Any health items needed
 - If you require a special diet or want certain kinds of foods or beverages we ask our customers to bring those with them

- We recommend that customers bring a 4x4 vehicle. We allow and encourage our customers to drive to and from the hunting area. This has proven to be the top choice of our customers and creates convenient logistics, as well as to have a vehicle at their spot for emergencies or in climate weather.
